## Leasing Office:

- Rent payments will no longer be accepted in person. Rent payments can be made:
  - 1. Online through the Website Portal at rentpontiac.com (if you do not have an account, we can set up your account.)
  - 2. Credit Card Payments will be accepted over the phone
  - 3. All Money Order and Checks must be dropped off in the rent box.
- All work orders must be made over the phone, online, or via text message to Cornerstone Townhomes. Receipts for these payments will be mailed to your resident address via USPS within 7-10 business days.

## Maintenance:

- All maintenance will proceed as usual, however we ask that residents respect the following guidelines:
- Please make all work order requests over the phone, email, website, fax, or text message.
- We ask that tenants leave their units during the duration of the work order being completed.
- If you cannot leave your unit for any reason, please keep a minimum of 10 feet distance between yourself and the maintenance personnel.
